Pledge Allegiance was led by Boy Scout Steven Fulstone.

Motion was made by Reggie Billups and seconded by Patty Hager to approve minutes of the May 5, 2008, regular session. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Brian Ellis and seconded by Reggie Billups to approve paying the bills from the General Fund. Motion carried. Call opposed.

Motion was made by Reggie Billups and seconded by Patty Hager to approve paying the bills from the Coal Severance Fund. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Brian Ellis and seconded by Reggie Billups to approve the General Fund Budget revision and submit to the State Tax Auditor. Fredda Ray, Finance Manager explained the budget revision. Motion carried. Call opposed.

Motion was made by Don Chaney and seconded by Patty Hager to have the first reading of ORDINANCE ARTICLE 1309 DEFINITIONS 1309.02 DEFINITION OF TERMS "ENCLOSED STRUCTURE" means a structure surrounded by walls or one continuous wall and having a roof enclosing the entire structure and includes a permanent appendage thereto. Motion carried. Councilwoman Call asked if this applied to Copart. Ms. Call was advised that Copart is zoned B-3 business and was approved for that business to located there.

Motion was made by Don Chaney and seconded by Brian Ellis to appoint Al Howard, 116 Southbrook to the Sanitary Board for a two-year term. Motion carried.

Charles Raines – Victorian Place – Mr. Raines stated that by city council not accepting the streets of Victorian Place that is was costing him \$3700 a year. The mayor advised Mr. Raines that the streets would be accepted when the housing development was complete. Mr. Raines stated that the city would be hearing from his attorney.

David Straley – Kelly’s Cove – Mr. Straley complained about the garbage pick up service from Cummings Collection. They are not running regularly. Also, Harbour Lane needs re-paved. The mayor advised that he and the city manager met with Cummings and things should be resolved within two weeks. The Public Service Commission regulates Cummings. Harbour Lane is a state road.
